The life you always wanted
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John 2: 1-11

As discussed on Sunday Jesus invites us into a life with Him of remarkable quality.

By performing this miracle Jesus was showing us:

- Who He came to be.
 - What He has to offer.
 - What Jesus has done for us.
 - What we have to do.
1. The first miracle of Jesus was a sign of what was yet to come, pointing towards something of much greater significance (John 2:11). Jesus wanted to show us that he offers us a remarkable quality of life filled with his presence. When did you first come to know Jesus? How has the quality of life that he offers affected your life?
 2. Most people have decided that the life they are looking for is more likely to be found in other places than in the church, such as success & relationships. What are the challenges of pursuing these good things without them becoming ultimate things? What are the benefits of doing so?
 3. When Jesus said “My time has not yet come”(Jn2:4), He was thinking about his death. This set us free from having to pursue other things as our gods (Rom 6:5-9) and brought us forgiveness for the way we had lived (Rom 3:22-24). What difference should this make to the way we live?
 4. Jesus invites us to a great feast – this is not an invitation to simply know of God, but instead an invitation to ‘taste and see that the Lord is good’ (Psalm 34:8). What do you think the difference is between ‘knowing’ and ‘tasting’? How can we ‘taste’ and experience more of God in our lives? Share about a time when you experienced him.
 5. Jesus provided 150 Gallons of the ‘best’ wine (Jn 2:6-9) – This was 75 cases, 5400 glasses of fine vintage wine. Jesus offers us a fresh start with a abundance of resources to live by – take some time praying together thanking Jesus for this wonderful provision.
